

Book of the Week



We will continue to focus on emotions and the effects different parts of our brain have on our emotions. Children will be introduced to Brain Breaks too.

Learning

We will be...

Maths – counting numbers and counting how many people are on the bus. How many windows does the bus have?

Writing – drawing and writing bus tickets;

Sounds – going on learning walks and listening to our environmental sounds. What kind of sounds can you hear at night?

Creative – making a bus out of junk modelling. What do you need to add to make your model look like a bus?

Gross Motor Skills – practising how to kick a ball.

Outdoors – reading road signs and building a bus out of blocks and chairs. Are there any road signs by your house? What do they mean?

Communication – role playing going on different journeys on a bus using a bus timetable.

Learning

We will be...

Maths – counting reliably with numbers 1-20, placing them in order and saying which is one more and one less.

Writing – exploring writing CVC words using s,a,t,p.

Sounds – focusing on I,n,m,d

Creative – making sculptures using wood, nails and screws.

Finger Gym – making shapes and patterns using Gioboards and rubber bands.

Outdoors – using the road signs to control the bike traffic safely.

Communication – recounting and role playing the story of Creation from our RE lesson.



Religious Education

We are focusing on Creation. What is precious to us? and why are all people precious to God?
