
Song of the week

Maths – focusing on number recognition. What numbers do we recognise? Can we count objects to match numbers?

Can we talk about what we have drawn and ascribe meaning to our pictures? Can we write our own names with support?

Phonics – focusing on assessing knowledge of initial sounds. Various activities on the following sounds: s,a,t,p.

Finger gym – using different mediums in which to trace our sounds of the week, for example, sand, paint and soil.

Creative – using our hands to paint.

Outdoors – focusing on movement with Miss Hollidge. Can we follow instructions and move safely in different directions? Can we adjust our speed and negotiate spaces?
