


Song of the week

We are continuing to learn a variety of songs for our Christmas Nativity.

Book of the week



We will focus on the book 'Stick Man'. "Stick Man lives in the family tree with his Stick Lady Love and their stick children three." But it's dangerous being a Stick Man. A dog wants to play with him, a swan builds her nest with him. He even ends up on a fire! Will he ever get back to the family tree?

Next week we will also be...

Maths – making loops from string, the children will be making shapes with their loops. Can you fit inside the shape?

Writing – writing postcards from Stick Man to his family. What happened to Stick Man on his adventures?

Phonics – focusing on the following sounds: **ck, e, u, r**. Can you think of some words with 'ck' in them?

Finger gym – carrying out a stick tower challenge using sticks, Sellotape and elastic bands.

Creative – creating our charcoal display in the outdoor shed using charcoal. Can you use lighter and darker shading in your drawings?

Outdoor learning – making Stick Man, and his family using sticks, elastic bands and masking tape. Can you make the Stick family different sizes?
