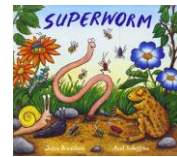


Song of the week

Next week we will also be...

Maths – sorting objects in order. Can we order toy worms by size? Can we use vocabulary to describe size?

Writing – writing facts about worms and mini-beasts. Can we label our pictures?

Can we write our names with support? Can we explore cursive script?

Phonics – focusing on assessing knowledge of initial sounds and carrying out various activities on the following sounds: g, o, c, k.

Finger gym – focusing on creating playdough worms. Can we talk about size and order what we make by size?

Creative – exploring worm trails. Can we use wool and string to create worm trails? We will also use rollers to paint the trails.

Outdoor learning – going on a worm hunt! Can we count how many worms we find? Where do worms like to live? Do we know why? We will explore how to move like minibeast
