Finger gym – We will be drawing patterns on the gingerbread man by following a pattern.

Creative – We will be making gingerbread men! We will then be decorating them.

Outdoors – We will be caring for our plants and vegetables. We will record when we water them and any changes that we see on a daily basis.

We will be focusing on ball skills and co-ordination. Reception's PE lesson will take place on Friday afternoon.
