Singing, "Hey Mr Shark, you can't catch me!"

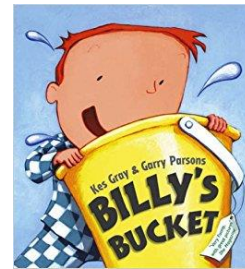
Along came Mr Shark, hungry for his tea
