Song of the week

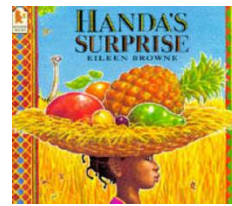
This week Reception will be learning songs for their graduation ceremony.

Nursery will be learning songs about growing fruits and vegetables.

Book of the week



We will be focusing on the story 'Handa's Surprise'. This is a colourful tale which tells of a young girl's journey carrying exotic fruits through an African village.

Next week we will also be...

Maths – We will be focusing on weighing and measuring different fruits. Can we make predictions about which fruits will be the heaviest and lightest?

Writing – We will be writing shopping lists and instructions for making an exotic fruit salad. What are our favourite fruits? What shall we put in our fruit salad?

Finger gym – We will be learning to use tools to cut fruits for our fruit salad.

Creative – We will be painting pictures of fruits from observation. Can we look at the insides of different fruits carefully and describe them?

Outdoors – We will be building huts with our wooden blocks and sticks to represent homes from the story 'Handa's Surprise'.

PE – We will be focusing on ball skills and co-ordination. Reception's PE lesson will take place on Wednesday afternoon.
