## Song of the week

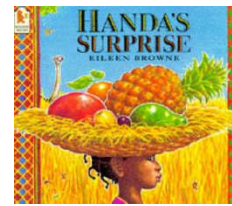
*This week Reception will be learning songs for their graduation ceremony.*

## Book of the week



We will be continuing to focus on the story 'Handa's Surprise'. This is a colourful tale which tells of a young girl's journey carrying exotic fruits through an African village.

## Next week we will also be...

**Maths** – We will be focusing on weighing and measuring different fruits. Can we make predictions about which fruits will be the heaviest and lightest? Can we record our findings?

**Writing** – We will be tasting exotic fruits and writing about what we like and dislike. We will use adjectives to describe tastes.

**Finger gym** – We will be learning to create repeated patterns using fruit dipped in paint. Can we create a 3-part pattern?

**Creative** – We will be painting pictures of fruits from observation. Can we look at the insides of different fruits carefully and describe them?

**Outdoors** – We will be building huts with our wooden blocks and sticks to represent homes from the story 'Handa's Surprise'.

**PE** – We will be focusing on ball skills and co-ordination. Reception's PE lesson will take place on Wednesday afternoon.
